"Children with Sexual Acting Out Behaviors"

February 12th, April 8th, June 10th, August 12th, October 14th
9am-11am at the FJC

"Children with Sexual Acting Out Behaviors" is a free, two-hour, introductory course for professionals working with children, sponsored by the Sexual Abuse Intervention Network. This course enables participants to distinguish between normal and problematic sexual behaviors in children. Topics including characteristics of sexually abusive youth, defining childhood sexual abuse, strategies for preventing further victimization and the legal process in Hillsborough County are also covered in this course.

Licensed mental health providers (LCSW, LMHC, LMFT and Psychologists) can receive 2 Continuing Education Credits through the Family Justice Center of Hillsborough County Provider #50-7820 (expires 3/2009).

Nut And Bolts: The Basics of Domestic Violence Advocacy (12 CEU's)
